

The Workshop

“Ancient Wisdom for Tomorrow’s Worship” is a one day workshop offered by the South Yarra Community Baptist Church to share the rich fruits of their unique worship adventures with the wider Church.

Through experience, reflection and discussion, participants will learn how the worship wisdom of the ancient church can renew and enrich the worship life of Christians in 21st century Australia.

Since it is likely that many participants will have commitments in their own churches on the Sunday morning, the workshop will commence at 12:30 pm with registration, welcomes, and lunch.

The afternoon will rotate three activities:

- exploring the structure, texts, action and theology of a worship service that weaves ancient structures and practices with contemporary language and concerns;
- discussions about the relationship between ancient liturgical practice, free-church convictions, and the emerging culture;
- singing, to make sure we don’t get talked-out and to prepare for the evening session.

The climax of the workshop will be participation in a full celebration of the Lord’s Word and Table. This will enable participants to experience how what they have learned all fits together. The day will then end with an evening meal.

Topics Explored

- Why there is a divide between worship styles which are easily marketable and those which nourish our innermost spirits and free us to live more deeply.
- Why we can know more about the early church’s patterns of worship now than most of our forebears did.
- Why some of the worship practices rejected by our free-church forebears may need to be recovered if we are to remain faithful to their reforming spirit.
- How worship services can combine structures that have stood the test of time with the vitality of present-day imagery and language.
- What is included in a worship service that is founded on the traditions of the ancient Church and how these components might be reworked for use in 21st century Australian society.
- How to move from a clergy monopoly to a high level of shared active participation in worship, without making it shallow, busy and fragmented.
- How to reconcile the tragic split between beautifully crafted liturgy and Spirit-filled spontaneity and enthusiasm.
- How the recovery of ancient forms can enable small churches to develop a worship life which is rich, profound and life-giving without needing the resources that only large churches can muster.

Presenters

Nathan Nettleton will be the main presenter for the Workshop. Nathan is the pastor to the South Yarra Community Baptist Church and teaches Worship Studies at Whitley College, the Baptist Theological College of Victoria. He represents the Baptist Union of Australia on the ecumenical Australian Consultation on Liturgy, and convenes an international discussion for Baptists engaged in scholarly reflection on worship and spirituality.



Other members of the South Yarra Community Baptist Church will also be involved in contributing to the discussion from their own experience and reflections.
